White wine

2013 Dom Pérignon, Vallée de la Marne, Champagne, France (C) 88 | -- | 545

Dom Pérignon is vintage champagne only. Each vintage is a creation, singular and unique, that expresses both the character of the year, and the character of Dom.

2018 Chardonnay, Mac Forbes 'Woori Yallock' Yarra Valley, Vic. (C) 34 | 84 | 165

Coming from a small, south facing, single vineyard 'the School House Block'. Hand-picked grapes fermented in old oak barrels with wild yeasts has created a very poised, integrated wine. At five years of age, this wine is now sitting in that perfect drinking window, with lovely secondary characteristics of baked apple, camomile and pie crust, gliding effortlessly across the palate.

2022 Viognier, Yalumba 'Virgilius' Eden Valley S.A. (V) 27 | 67 | 131

Viognier is a white grape variety that calls Condrieu in the Northern Rhone Valley of France, home. Yalumba's Flagship white wine, the Virgilius Viognier, is often regarded as Australia's benchmark Viognier. Planted in 1980, these old vines are handpicked, whole-bunch pressed to mature French oak barrels & fermented by 'wild' yeasts.

Showing lifted ginger, layered minerality & sourdough-like texture with subtle almond & apricots & savouriness.

Red wine

2021 Rosé, Cobaw Ridge 'il pinko Syrah' Macedon Ranges, Vic. (C) 31 | 76 | 149

Rosé made from 100% organic & biodynamically grown Syrah. Fermented and aged for twelve months in qevri (egg-shaped clay vessels designed to be buried underground) and old French oak, both of which bring intriguing textures to this wine. With refreshing mineral driven acidity, the palate shows exotic spices interwoven with pomegranate & raspberry, flavours, that continue through an extraordinarily long finish.

2021 Pinot Noir, Eastern Peake 'Intrinsic' Ballarat, Vic. (C) (V) 46 | 114 | 225

Burgundian in style and produced from 40 to 27 year old vines, at 430m altitude on volcanic grey loam soils sitting over weathered basalt. Spontaneous fermentation via indigenous yeasts, basket pressed & transferred into oak barrique barrels.

A mix of tart berry fruits interspersed with sage and sweet spice, there's a refreshing, mineral acidity pulling the wine through and those really fine, powdery and taut tannins that rise up and hone and shape all that expressive fruit into a long, fine finish.

2022 Langhe Nebbiolo, G.D. Vajra, Piedmont, Italy (C) 30 | 75 | 145

Perfumes are vibrant, with a floral bouquet of rose petals, violets and fresh berries, hints of dark fruit, lavender and mint. Elegant and complex on the palate with layers of crunchy red fruits, orange peel, sweet spices with earthy and mineral undertones.

2019 Syrah, Man O' War 'Dreadnought' Waiheke Island, NZ. (C) 34 | 84 | 165

Grow on the steep hillside vineyards of Waiheke Island 20km west of Auckland, New Zealand. Hand picked, wild fermented & hand made with great care, creating a unique wine of complexity & charm. Medium to full bodied, blueberry, blackberry, dark cherry, plum and a touch of liquorice, cocoa & coffee with an earthy smoky lift.

Spot light on a Producer

Joh. Jos. Prüm

Region: Mosel, Germany

Wine Maker: Dr Katharina Prüm

Importantly, 90% of the Estate's vines are ungrafted with an average age exceeding 60 years. There are a number of key parcels aged between 70 and 100 years and more. This has all kinds of implications for yield and quality. Then, the picking dates are exceptionally precise, every parcel is picked only when perfectly ripe (subject to Pradikat) and often with multiple passes.

In the winery the winemaking is as natural as possible with as little intervention as possible: natural yeast, unrushed fermentation and patient aging on lees—the wines are never rushed and are only bottled when ready. This extra time on natural lees means the wines absorb everything the lees have to give (this sometimes means some gentle reduction and wines that need some time to unwind). Finally, the Prüm family is a family of perfectionists. They are only interested in producing greatness and honouring the remarkable vineyards and ancient vines that they are blessed to farm.

All four of Prüm's key vineyards share the same soils—grey and blue Devonian slate—and south-to-south westerly aspects. They all sit alongside each other, on the one continuous slope, between Bernkastel and Zeltingen in the middle Mosel. Bernkasteler Badstube, then Graacher Himmelreich, then Wehlener Sonnenuhr, then Zeltinger Sonnenuhr. That's the order of the vineyards travelling north up the river from Bernkastel (or northwest to be precise). These vineyards have been in continuous production for some 2000 years! The major differences between the sites have to do with the variation in the aspect (from south to southwest), the steepness and the depth of the soil. It sounds so subtle and yet the wines that result are all so wonderfully distinctive.

All the vineyards of J.J. Prüm are renowned, yet it is the majestic Wehlener Sonnenuhr vineyard that is the most famous. This revered site lies opposite the village of Wehlen and the Estate owns seven hectares—largely planted to ungrafted wines—which has very thin topsoil over Devonian slate (in some areas of the vineyard the plants grow out of pure rock). Wehlener Sonnenuhr has the highest pure stone content of all the Prüm vineyards, and along with neighbouring Zeltinger, is the steepest of Prüm's vineyards—a dizzying 65-70% gradient in places. Stuart Pigott puts it well when he notes that, "In top vintages the Wehlener Sonnenuhr yields the richest, silkiest, most seductive wines on the Mosel. The fame of these Rieslings is inextricably linked with that of the Joh Jos Prüm estate."

Amber & Amphora by the Bottle

Amber wine, also known as orange wine, is a type of wine made from white wine grapes. In typical white wine production the grape skins are removed, whereas with amber wine production the skin is left in contact with the juice for days or even months. The skins contain colour pigment, phenols and tannins, this gives amber wine its colour, flavour, & texture.

Amphora, experiencing a renaissance across the globe, these clay vessels pre date wooden barrels by 6,000 years. Clay can be thought of as a middle ground between steel and oak. Like oak, clay is porous, so it does allow for some oxygen giving the wine a deep and rich texture, but like steel it's a neutral material that won't impart any additional flavours.

2021 Zibibbo Blend, Unico Zelo 'Esoterico' Riverland & Clare Valley, S.A. (V) 84
Zibibbo, Gewürztraminer, Moscato Giallo, Greco di Tufo & Fiano. No additions of any kind - save for sulphur when bottled. There is no fining or filtration involved, with the wine allowed to clarify by gravity alone - resulting in a slight haze and sediment. A textured & aromatic wine showing green apple, guava & lime zest.

2022 Alpha Box & Dice, Italian Plastic 'Golden' Fleurieu Peninsula, S.A. (V) 81
A blend of Semillon, Muscat and Gewurztraminer, with some time on skins. Ripe stone fruits, exotic spice and a refreshingly delicious grip soar throughout this wine.

2018 Ruggabellus 'Sallio' Eden Valley, S.A. (V) 118
More or less equal parts semillon, muscat and riesling from old vines, spends an average of three & a half days on skins & rests on lees for a year, unfiltered so expect it to be cloudy. Palate is, chalky, tight and refreshing but shows depth too. Bergamot tea, marmalade, caramalised apple. Wild edged and delicious. Complex, energetic, elegant but balanced.

2011 Tocai Friulano, Radikon 'Jakot' Friuli-Venezia Giulia, Italy (V) 500ml 145
100% Tocai Friulano, destemmed, crushed and fermented with natural yeasts in oak vat with no temperature control & no sulfur. Then left on skins for 3 months. After a gentle pressing, the wine is racked to Rover Casks, 3500-liter Friulian-made French oak botti for a year on its lees; without filtration & then aged in bottle for a year before release. Beautifully balanced & complex palate of orange marmalade & blossom, bergamot tea, hazelnut & dried apricot with a long finish.

2016 Frank Cornelissen 'Munjebel' Mt. Etna, Sicily, Italy (V) 260
The vineyards are located between 620 & 750m in the volcanic soils of Mount Etna's northern valley. A blend of 60% Grecanico Dorato & 40% Carricante of 40+ year old vines. Fermentation with indigenous yeasts & skin maceration for approximately 4 days. It is beautifully pure for a natural wine, with aromas and flavors of guava, quince & yellow apple.

2017 Moscato di Alessandria, Occhipinti 'SP68 Bianco' Sicily, Italy (V) 135
60% Moscato di Alessandria / 40% Albanello, produced organically from 15 year old vines at 280m above sea level. Fermentation with indigenous yeast with 15 days of maceration on skins. Aged for 6 months in concrete & 1 month in bottle, unfiltered. Light & fragrant with beautiful aromatics & sappy acid this is a natural wine classic.
